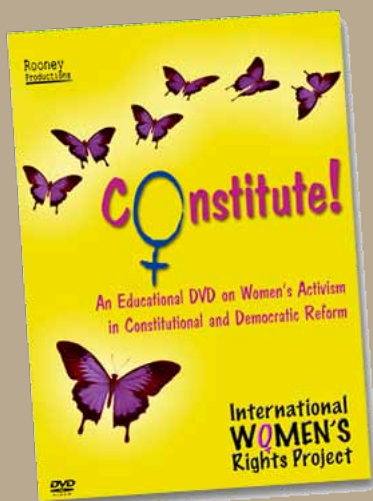


To Celebrate the 30th Anniversary of
